After twenty years of serving in Philadelphia, we have made the decision to end our outings to the city due to changes caused by the pandemic. The most significant change was the number of people served during our outings. We learned that there are many new organizations serving in the city. Many of the people we had been serving regularly were now being served by those other organizations. Due to these changes, the leadership team spent much time praying about whether to continue in Philadelphia or to seek out opportunities to serve "closer to home" in Gloucester County. We eventually concluded that it was time to end our outings to Philadelphia. The people in Philadelphia will always hold a special place in our hearts and we continue to pray for them daily, but we are excited about an opportunity that has come up for us in Gloucester County. First United Methodist Church in Williamstown, used to hold a monthly dinner for anyone in their community that needed a hot meal. The pandemic caused the church to stop holding these dinners. These monthly dinners came to mind. I thought that if we could find a church with a kitchen and social hall, we could hold our own monthly dinners for those in need in that community. I happened to be brain storming this idea with my mom one day. She mentioned it to her pastor the next morning. He very quickly told her to have me contact him so we could discuss the possibility of partnering with them to hold these dinners. After speaking with him and some members of their church it was decided that we will hold our first community dinner in January of 2023. We are very excited about this opportunity and are currently working with a team at Williamstown Methodist on the details of the dinner. Our hope is that other churches will come along side us to work together to make this happen. We will provide more information as it becomes available, but we ask for continued prayer as we work on the details. This is an exciting opportunity for us and one we have been praving about for a long time.
