"The Spirit of the Lord is upon me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim freedom for prisoners and recovery of sight for the blind, to set the oppressed free, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor." — Luke 4:18–19

With this declaration, Jesus wasn't just describing His mission — He was defining the mission of every believer who would follow Him. He revealed that the gospel is not merely a message to be spoken but a life to be lived, carried with compassion into the darkest corners of human experience.

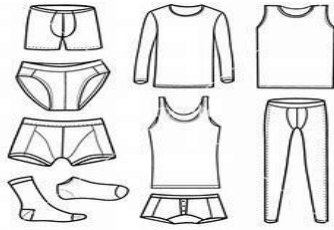
